This year <u>Jubilee Christmas will joyfully serve 185 families in Daviess County</u>. CONNECTIONS, a program of Daviess County Partnership, invites the parents of qualified families into the Jubilee Gift Shops set up in fourteen area Site churches. Partner churches provide gifts and volunteers for this Jubilee event. Parents select and gift-wrap three toys plus stocking stuffers for each of their children. Church volunteers share this music-filled event creating an atmosphere of true DIGNITY, RESPECT, and GOOD CHEER for our guests. Leaving with lifted spirits and toys to place under their tree these parents can anticipate a joyful Christmas morning!

Westminster and First Christian members are shopping now for gifts to match the gender/age/price designated on ornaments selected from our Jubilee Giving Tree. Return the unwrapped toys with the ornament tags attached to the church by Sunday, December 3th. (Remember the gifts are to be toys, not clothing. Please, no toy guns. Thanks!) Rather not shop? 
